Her book entitled Journey to the Holocaust: Anti-Semitism, the Bible and History was published in Finland in April 2014 and reprinted in 2017. Her book on Antisemitism was published in April 2022.

She is working as a Consultant for the Holocaust Garden of Hope. She is also teaching in Finland as well as online globally, and frequently contributes to TV and radio programs as well as publications around the world.
